### Woodland Elf: Free Girl Mod

# Supplies:

Yarn changes: **Leggings** (instead of **Pants**)

Skirt

*Hat* (use a totally separate color)

Hair



### Arms:

Follow pattern

## Legs:

Follow pattern, substituting *Leggings* for *Pants* 

## **Body:**

Follow pattern, substituting *Leggings* for *Pants*.

R10: Change to *Skirt* (No clean color change needed)

**R11:** SC around in BLO (48)

**R15**: HDC around (48)

Change to **Shirt** using the Clean Color Change technique.

**R16:** SC around (48)

R17: Follow R15 of pattern R18: Follow R16 of pattern R19: Follow R17 of pattern R20-21: Continue pattern

Before adding arms, you will be making the skirt.

At the back of the body, pull **Skirt** into the exposed front loop of the last st of **R11**. Hold the body upside down and work backwards. Skirt is worked in DCs.

- Ch2, DC in same st. INC around. Join with a SISt with top of Ch2.
  (96)
- Ch2, DC in same st. DC around. Join with a SISt with top of Ch2.(96)
- Ch2, DC in same st. DC around. Join with a SISt with top of Ch2.(96) FO and weave in ends.

R22: Continue pattern and finish elf

### Hat:

I made my hat with 2 colors. I decided to use an unused color for the main, and made a band using *Leggings*. I chose not to do the underside of the hat in the main pattern for this one, but that decision is totally up to you!

To add a small band:

After **R28**, change to band color using the clean color change technique. Count the slst round of the color change as **R29** and the sc in BLO of the color change as **R30** 

Change back to the main hat color at **R30** and proceed with the pattern but do not sew on the hat.

### Hair:

### Hair around the inside of the hat

Before sewing the hat onto the head, you will want to add the elf's hair onto the hat. Hold the hat upside down, with the back of the hat away from you. With *Hair*, make a SISt and pull it into the BLO of **R31** on the inside of the hat. Working around the hat counter-clockwise, make a <u>twisted SC</u> st in the BLO of **R31** around. Join and weave in ends.

### **Bangs**

Make a MR with a 3" tail. \*Ch6. SISt in 2nd st from hook and back down ch. SC into MR\*. Repeat \*-\* one or two more times. Trim a 3" tail and pull MR closed. Tie tails to the hairline.Trim and hide ends inside the hat.

#### **Braids**

Make a MR with a 3" tail. \*Ch26. SISt in 2nd st from hook and back down ch. SC into MR\*. Repeat \*-\* two more times. Trim a 3" tail and pull MR closed. Tie ends together and onto the hairline in front of the ears. Trim and hide ends inside the hat. Braid the 3 strands together and tie with a hair tie.





### Hair Ties (make 2)

Using whatever color you wish, make a slip knot and ch25 using a very tight tension. Trim and pull tight. Tie around the end of the braids.

Now sew the hat onto the head using the band color if you made one, or the main color if not. Follow the original pattern to shape the hat.
